MAKE A STATUE OF LIBERTY TORCH EPISODE 1 – STATUE OF LIBERTY

Materials: 1 paper bowl, 1 paper towel tube, 1 roll or a few sheets of yellow or orange cellophane, turquoise paint, scissors, glue

Instructions:

1. Place the paper towel tube in the center of the paper bowl and trace around it. Have an adult help you cut out the hole you have traced.
2. Paint the paper towel tube and the paper bowl with the turquoise paint. Leave on some newspaper until they dry.
3. Insert the tube into the hole you cut previously on the bowl and glue it in place. The top of the tube should be level with the top of the bowl.
4. Cut out the flame pattern and lay it down on the cellophane. Trace it. Then pick up the pattern and place it down right next to where you just finished tracing and trace it again. If you want the flame to be thicker, pick up the pattern one more time and trace it a third time. Have an adult help you cut out the pattern that you traced onto the cellophane.
5. Roll up the cellophane and glue it into the top of the paper towel roll as shown in the diagram. If you find it difficult to trace onto the cellophane, then roll up a piece of cellophane measuring approximately 8 inches wide by 5 inches high. Glue it into the tube and then cut out flame shapes. If you want a thicker flame, then use a longer piece or a few sheets of cellophane.
